



Parent Responsibilities

Payments

The 2008-2009 season starts September 2nd. Dues for the entire season are \$350. There is a nonrefundable \$50 registration fee due at sign up with the \$300 balance due within 30 days. Siblings will receive a \$100 discount.

This structure is for both the fall and spring season so it is to your rower's advantage to sign up early. The membership dues will be the same after September 2nd whether you start rowing in September or January.

Registration Packet

All paperwork & forms must be turned in before rower is allowed to participate on the team and out on the water. Please respect this and have all paperwork turned in at one time.

Regatta Transportation

It is your responsibility to transport your rower to all regattas. Carpooling is encouraged. Please remember that rowers are NOT allowed to drive themselves to a regatta, regardless of the rower's age.

Volunteers

ROCCS is completely run by volunteers. **We need your help!** There are many committees you may volunteer to be part of. Attend monthly parent meetings. All families are expected to take part in all regattas to help with set up, food, and break down of a regatta site.

****Please read your email weekly. Email is our primary means of communication.**

Withdrawal

If your rower quits ROCCS for any reason, including illness or injury, you must mail in a withdrawal letter to PO BOX 50, Lecanto, FL 34460. Until that letter is received you are still responsible for all financial obligations.

Fundraising

Since ROCCS is a non-profit organization and does not receive support from any other organization, fundraising is necessary for expenses and continued growth. It is expected that members of ROCCS, Inc and their families provide support for our fundraisers by participating fully in the events organized by our committees.

Financial Obligations

Dues cover annual rowing expenses plus such other items as, regatta fees, coach's salaries, supplies, and team equipment.

Unisuit - Unisuit cost is approximately \$90.00 (new rowers & replacement). The organization does not profit from the sale of unisuits.

Fundraising- participation and support are required.

Individual Regatta travel & overnight stays (approximately one per season) are at the rower's expense.
